MINUTES No. 1 - ESTABLISHMENT OF SELECTION CRITERIA

Postdoctoral Research Scholarships

Reference: eGamesLab

On April 10, 2023, at 12:00 pm, the jury, composed of Prof. Pedro Campos (UMa), who chairs, Prof. Élvio Rúbio Gouveia (UMa), and Dr. Lucas Pereira (IST) to establish the admissibility and selection criteria to be applied to applicants for Post-Doctoral Research Scholarships with the reference indicated above.

The Jury follows the admissibility criteria defined in the tender notice, namely:

- a) That the doctor's degree has been obtained in the three years prior to the start date of the fellowship.
- b) That research activities do not require post-doctoral experience.
- c) That research activities have a period of development and execution equal to or less than three years.
- d) The scholarship holder does not exceed, with the conclusion of the scholarship contract in question, including possible renewals, an accumulated period of three years in that type of scholarship, consecutive or interpolated, and the candidate must deliver a declaration, under oath, of the scholarships which he has enjoyed since obtaining the Doctor's degree, mentioning duration and host entity.
- e) Not having benefited, for the same purpose, from an identical type of scholarship.

Regarding the selection criteria, and again based on the call for tender, it was established that candidates would be evaluated based on:

a) in a letter of motivation; maximum of 30 points to be awarded as follows:

The letter is very well written and organized, revealing the candidate's interest and suitability for the position in question. (30 points)

The letter is sufficiently well written and organized, revealing sufficient interest and suitability of the candidate for the position in question. (15 points)

The letter is not well written or organized, and/or does not reveal the candidate's interest and suitability for the position in question. (0 points)

- b) in the Curriculum Vitae; maximum of 70 points to be awarded as follows:
- b.1) Scientific publications in the contest areas (Maximum 30 points)
- b.2) Experience in areas relevant to the Mobilizing Agenda for Business Innovation eGamesLab (Maximum 20 points)
- b.3) Other experience not directly related to the Agenda, but with significant importance for the work plan (Maximum 10 points)
- b.4) Other curriculum aspects (eg participation in projects, participation in conferences, etc.) (Maximum 10 points)

The Jury also decided at this meeting:

- a) That, after ordering the candidates based on the final score achieved, only those who obtain a minimum of 50 points will be hired.
- b) Apply as a tiebreaker, the best score obtained in the set of items (a) to (b) of the selection criteria; in the event of a tie, an individual interview may be held (at a distance or in person).
- c) That candidates accepted in the competition should be contacted by the President of the Jury to, if applicable, reconfirm their interest and availability to accept the position. The President of the Jury was further mandated to, if necessary, request additional information or documentation from the candidates.
- d) That, if item (a) above is verified, if the candidate selected in first place does not accept the place or withdraws from the competition, the candidate placed second (first alternate) will replace the candidate selected in first place and, so on, successively until the place is filled.

All defined criteria were approved unanimously.

There being nothing else to discuss, these minutes were drawn up and signed by the members of the jury, Prof. Pedro Campos, Prof. Élvio Rúbio Gouveia and Dr. Lucas Pereira.
